### MODULE 1 — RELATIONSHIPS

WAI\_Relationships\_Agent.md

Maps your full stakeholder landscape, runs a trust diagnostic for each key relationship, and preps you for the 3–5 conversations that determine your political capital in the first 90 days. **Output: stakeholder map, trust gaps, AOS prep sheets, 7-day action plan.**

### MODULE 2 — STRATEGY

WAI\_Strategy\_Agent.md

Helps you read what the strategy actually says — not what the document says — diagnose whether the org is built to execute it, and locate the two places where your personal attention moves the most. **Output: strategy assessment, org design findings, leverage map, 90-day success pictures.**

## MODULE 3 — TEAMS

WAI\_Teams\_Agent.md

Builds a behavioral capability assessment, identifies structural vs. individual gaps, redistributes development work to the people who need it, and scripts the Handoff and SBI conversations to activate it. **Output: capability map, development distribution plan, two conversation scripts.**

### WHERE TO START

## RECOMMENDED SEQUENCE: STRATEGY » RELATIONSHIPS » TEAMS.

Strategy first — it defines what the org needs to win, which sets the context for every conversation and every development decision that follows. That said: if you have an urgent problem right now, start with the relevant module. Each agent is designed to stand alone.

START HERE	<b>Module 2 · Strategy</b>	Understand how this org intends to win before you invest attention anywhere else. Most VPs skip this and spend 90 days on the wrong work.
THEN	<b>Module 1 · Relationships</b>	Stakeholder trust is the political capital that makes your strategy executable. Without it, the right answer doesn't land.
THEN	<b>Module 3 · Teams</b>	Build the system to develop your team — based on what the strategy actually requires, not who's easiest to work with.

FOUR STEPS · UNDER TWO MINUTES

# START A SESSION.

Open your AI tool. Upload the file. Type two words. The rest is the work.

- 1 OPEN YOUR AI TOOL**

Claude (claude.ai), ChatGPT (chat.openai.com), or Gemini (gemini.google.com). All three work. Claude tends to hold the challenge logic most precisely — but use what you already have open.
- 2 UPLOAD THE AGENT FILE**

Click the paperclip / attachment icon. Upload the .md file for the module you want to run. The file is the entire session — frameworks, challenge logic, Sterling's voice, output format — in one upload.
- 3 TYPE: "LET'S BEGIN."**

That's it. The agent opens the session and walks you through each stage. You don't explain the framework. You don't set it up. You just answer — honestly.
- 4 DO THE ACTUAL WORK**

The agent will push back when you give a vague answer. That's the point. The diagnostic only works if you give it the real picture, not the managed version. At the end, you'll have a structured output — a map, an assessment, a plan — that you can save and act on that day.

## HOW TO GET THE MOST OUT OF EACH SESSION

# FIVE THINGS THAT SEPARATE A USEFUL SESSION FROM A WASTED ONE.

**Be honest, not managed.** The agent will challenge vague answers. If you give the polished version, you'll get polished advice. Give the real version. Nobody else is reading this.

**Block 45–60 minutes.** Each session is a full diagnostic. It's not a quick query. The value is in working through the stages properly — not rushing to the output.

**Save the output.** At the end of each session, the agent produces a structured summary: your stakeholder map, capability assessment, leverage priorities. Copy it. Save it. That is the asset — not the conversation.

**Run each agent more than once.** The Strategy agent is worth running every 90 days. The Relationships agent every time your stakeholder landscape changes. These are repeatable tools, not one-time reads.

**Use the outputs in real conversations.** The AOS prep sheet goes into your stakeholder meetings. The SBI script goes into your coaching conversations. The leverage map goes into your next 1:1 with your boss. The output is the bridge between the session and the real work.
